\* \* \* It appears from the above, that the Town is divided into 26 streets, 26 places, 30 lanes, 66 courts, and 4 rows,—but it must be observed, that these are exclusive of *Mount Pleasant*, *Ginns*, and *New Houses*; the whole number of houses in which are about 520.—The last-mentioned place, (*New Houses*) consists of 3 rows, containing together 320 comfortable dwellings, uniformly built, (two stories high) and the inhabitants are supposed to be not less than two thousand!—These, added to the number particularised in the specified List of Streets, &c. will make a total of 3036.
