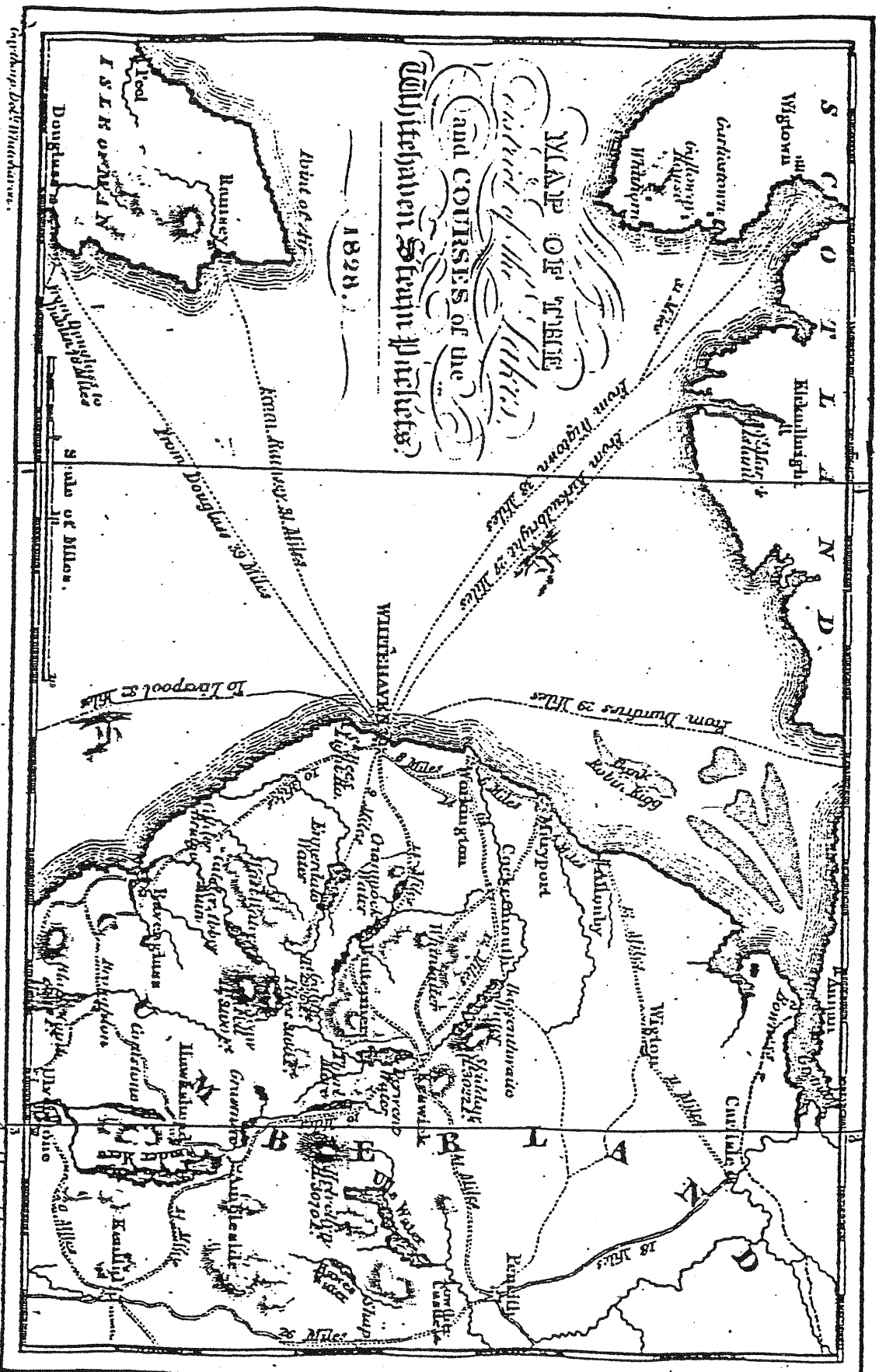

FROM WHITEHAVEN TO THE UNDERMENTIONED PORTS:—

TO LIVERPOOL,

Every Monday and Thursday Evening; returning from Liverpool every Wednesday and Sunday Morning.

TO DUMFRIES,

Every Monday and Thursday Morning; returning the same Day.

Coaches leave Dumfries daily for Edinburgh, by way of Moffat and by Lark; for Glasgow, by Kilmarnock and by Lannark; also, for Carlisle and Port Patrick.

TO GARLESTOWN, OR KIRKCUDBRIGHT,

Every Wednesday Morning; returning the same Day.

TO DOUGLAS IN THE ISLE OF MAN,

Every Friday Morning early; calling on her return from Dublin every Saturday Evening.
